

## What should retailers know?

Both managers and employees have an important role in helping law enforcement stop meth production.

Managers:	Employees:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use Meth Watch decals throughout the store.</li><li>• Place meth-related products in staffed or monitored areas.</li><li>• Position Meth Watch shelf tags near meth-related products.</li><li>• Limit the number of meth-related items on display.</li><li>• Make sure <b>all</b> employees understand the Meth Watch program.</li><li>• Tell your employees to <b>never</b> confront someone suspected of being on meth.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be aware of large-quantity purchases of meth-related items.</li><li>• Be alert to people purchasing combinations of meth-related items.</li><li>• Watch for theft of meth-related items.</li><li>• Look for erratic or suspicious behavior.</li><li>• Follow your store's procedures if you think someone may be on meth.</li><li>• Never confront someone suspected of being on meth.</li></ul>
